A timetable will be produced, once all requests have been received.

NB: All fees must be paid to Huntingdonshire Music School and accompaniment pieces handed in at time of exam entry.

Music

Candidates are expected to provide their own sheet music for the examination including music for the accompanist when required.

Aural

Your instrumental teacher should be assisting you with aural as part of your examination preparation. CD's and telephone apps are also available from the ABRSM to assist with this.

Examination Timetable

The exam timetable is usually available two weeks before the exam date(s).

We are not able to request specific times or dates for exams. We can however enter candidates in the order that we would like them to be examined. This order is not guaranteed by the board however.

Please note that even when you have been allocated a time for your exam that timings can change. For example, ABRSM rules state that if one person drops out all other times should be moved forwards and that changes can happen at short notice.

Late Entries

Huntingdonshire Music School cannot accept entries handed in after the closing date.

Certificates

Mark sheets will be available at reception on a Saturday once received from the board. If you do not attend on a Saturday it will be passed on via your teacher. Certificates will be presented to candidates at the next end of term concert.
